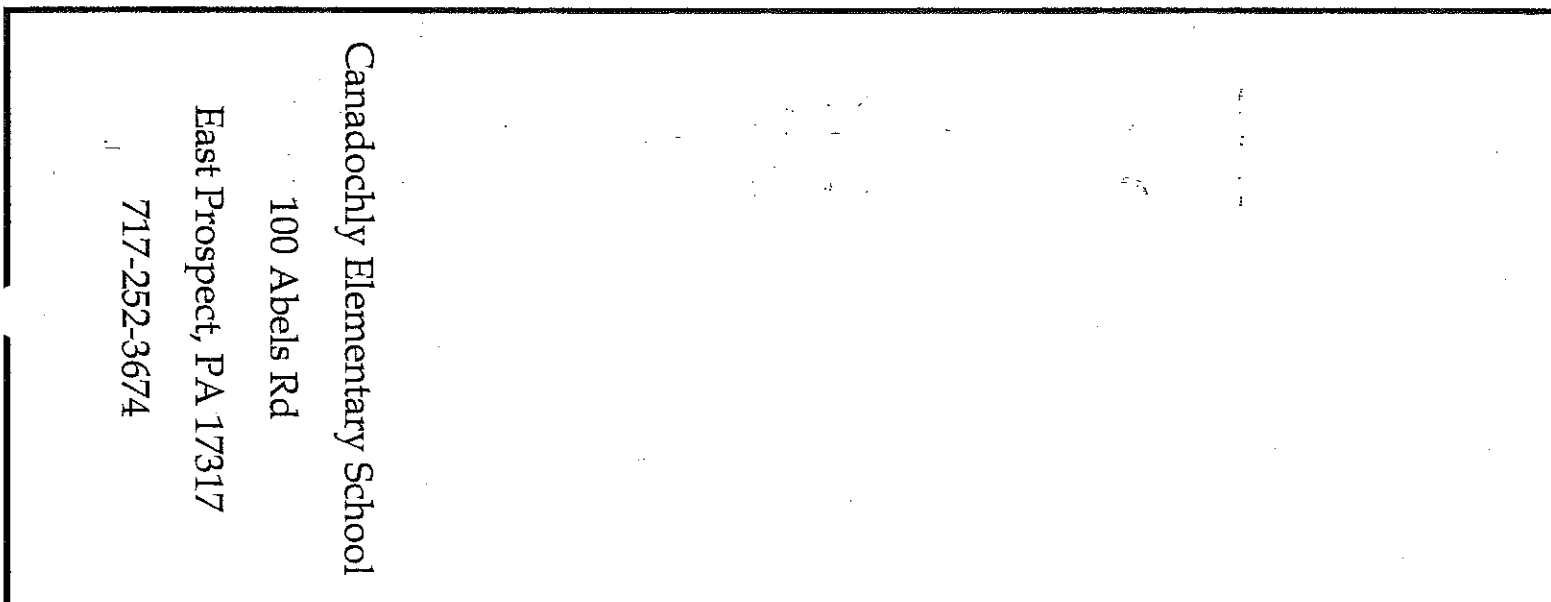
Dear Parents,

Throughout the school year, we encourage you to attend parent meetings and conferences. The meetings and conferences will give you ideas to use at home with your child.

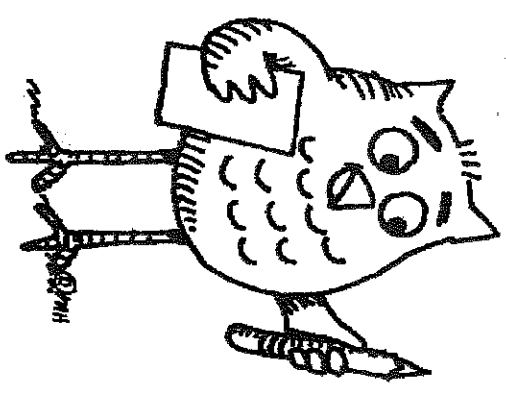

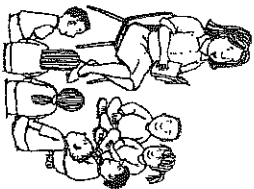
